Volunteers are essential to Lydia's programs and services. Working together with staff, Volunteers are expected to:

- Enjoy volunteering.
- Contribute in meaningful ways
- Share and learn
- Be caring, honest, respectful, and responsible

Volunteers may expect:

- A professional and safe volunteer environment
- Adequate information and training
- Trust and respect from staff and co-Volunteers
- Ongoing support and supervision
- Recognition for a job well done



Volunteer Opportunities

- Errand Volunteers - pick up donated items from the community.
- Event Volunteers - help at awareness events and collection drives.
- Fundraising Volunteers - coordinate or assist with fundraising.
- Lodging Volunteers - assist in lodging where patients lodge to be near area cancer treatment.
- Office Volunteers - assist in the office.
- Outreach Volunteers - help at support events; or make visits at area hospitals; or write encouraging messages from home; or make outreach calls from the agency.
- Prayer Volunteers - pray at the agency Thursday mornings for individuals asking for prayer.
- Production Volunteers - match, cut, and coordinate fabric material.
- Repair Volunteers - assist with minor repairs at the agency.
- Sewing Volunteers - sew and/or monogram Lydia totes and retail.



Getting started is easy:

1. Visit the agency or theylydiaproject.org to find and complete the Volunteer Application.
2. Once an application has been received, Lydia staff will call to schedule New Volunteer Orientation for applicants.
3. Orientations are on the 2nd Saturday, 11:15am, and third Thursday, 12:30pm, of each month. The Orientations provide information about the agency, services, and more about volunteer opportunities.
4. Groups wanting to volunteer contact the agency to coordinate group service time.
